We provide biblical teaching in our weekend services, preaching through all 66 books of the Bible in a seven-year rotation. While we may not cover every verse in our preaching rotation, we aim to familiarize people with the Bible's overarching themes and the beauty of God's story. Our approach is to "major on the majors," focusing on the core truths of scripture while equipping disciples to study the Word of God.



GROW


FOUNDATIONAL TRUTHS

CURRICULUM / FOUNDATIONAL OBJECTIVES

This resilient child discipleship is built on a clear picture of Jesus and the Gospel. We use discipleship building curriculum in both HopeKids Sundays and Midweek.

At **HopeKids Sundays (PreK-5th)** every year children learn Bible lessons from Genesis to Revelation. Weekly in grade-specific classes, they will connect with God as they read the Bible, have opportunities to grow in Jesus and are challenged to serve God through practical application of the lessons. We use media, games, crafts and activities to reinforce the Bible story. Twice a month, during HopeKids Sunday, children gather together for **Jesus and Music Time** (JAM Time) where they experience worship through music, Bible memory work and deeper Bible Truths.

HopeKids Sundays (Birth-3 years old) In our **Infant** room your child will be surrounded by a clean, safe environment along with some occasional bubbles! We guarantee plenty of snuggles and music. All of our volunteers are background checked. **Toddlers** have brains that are wired to super-absorb information. They also have very short attention spans. Because toddlers discover their world through play and repetition, the teacher provides many opportunities during the class, using crafts, singing, dancing, Bible story, and Bible review.

At **HopeKids Midweek** children will learn that their true identity can be found in Jesus Christ. In large group, we have a time of worship, video Bible lessons, object lessons and Bible memory time. In grade-specific small group time, they interact with the Bible lesson and a volunteer who loves and cares about their faith journey.
